Subpart M Personnel for Nonwaived Testing

☐ a Doctor of medicine or osteopathy license to practice medicine or osteopathy or be certified in anatomic and/or clinical pathology by the American Board of Pathology or the American Osteopathic Board of Pathology or possess the qualifications that are equivalent to those required for such
☐ a Doctor of of medicine, osteopathy or podiatric medicine licensed to practice medicine, osteopathy or podiatry and have received laboratory or experience consisting of at least one year directing or supervising waived laboratory testing or have at least 20 continuing medical education credit hours in laboratory practice commensurate with the laboratory's responsibilities or laboratory training equivalent
☐ Earned a doctoral degree in a chemical, biological, physical, or laboratory science from an accredited institution or the American Board of Medical Microbiology, Immunology or have at least one year of laboratory experience or supervising non-waived laboratory testing
☐ Earned master's degree in chemical, biological or clinical laboratory science, have at least one year of laboratory experience, chemical, physical, biological or clinical laboratory experience, have at least two years of laboratory experience in a laboratory, have at least two years of supervising non-waived laboratory testing and have at least one year of supervisory laboratory experience in non-waived testing, or have been a laboratory director, previously qualified or could have qualified as a laboratory director
